

**ACQUISITION BY UNIVERSAL HEALTH SERVICES, INC. (UHS)
THROUGH CYGNET HEALTH CARE LIMITED (CYGNET) OF THE
CAMBIAN ADULT SERVICES BUSINESS (CAS)**

Derogation from Interim Order

Background

- A. On 17 May 2017, the CMA made an Interim Order and adopted the derogations to the Phase 1 Initial Enforcement Order to that date.
- B. The Interim Order prohibits certain actions without the prior consent of the CMA.

Derogation requests and CMA consent

- 1. On 20 September 2017, Cygnet requested the following derogation from the Interim Order
 - (a) To allow CAS to negotiate and enter into a settlement agreement with [an employee] [REDACTED].
- 2. After due consideration of a request from Cygnet, the CMA consents to a derogation from paragraph 5(i) of the Interim Order, to enable an agreement to be finalised with the employee.
