## JUDGMENT

1. The Claimant's claim that the Respondent made unlawful deductions from wages are well founded to the extent that the Respondent made shortfalls in payment totalling £110.99 in the payment of the Claimant's pay.
2. By Consent, the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of £110.99.
3. It is further declared that the Respondent unlawfully deducted a sum of statutory sick pay that should have been paid on 28 July 2017. The said sum was paid in August 2017 and there is no order for repayment of this sum.
4. The Tribunal has no jurisdiction to entertain such other parts of the Claimant's claims not identified above.
