JUDGMENT

It is the unanimous judgment of the Tribunal that:-

- 1. The complaint of failure to make a reasonable adjustment succeeds and is upheld.
- 2. The complaint of breach of s15 Equality Act 2010 in respect of the suspension succeeds and is upheld.
- 3. The complaint of unfair dismissal succeeds and is upheld.
- 4. The Tribunal finds that compensation for unfair dismissal be reduced by 100% both by reason of Polkey and contributory fault.
- 5. The complaint of breach of s15 in respect of dismissal fails and is dismissed.
- 6. The complaint of breach of contract fails and is dismissed.
