## JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claim of age discrimination is dismissed, upon withdrawal.
- 2. The Claimant's claim of constructive unfair dismissal fails and is dismissed.
- The Claimant has paid fees in connection with this claim. In R (on the application of UNISON) v Lord Chancellor [2017] UKSC 51, the Supreme Court decided that it was unlawful for Her Majesty's Courts and Tribunals Service (HMCTS) to charge fees of this nature. HMCTS has undertaken to repay such

fees. In these circumstances I shall draw to the attention of HMCTS that this is a case in which fees have been paid and are therefore to be refunded to the Claimant. The details of the repayment scheme are a matter for HMCTS.
