DEFAULT JUDGMENT

1. The claims for unpaid wages and breach of contract as set out in the claim form are declared to be well-founded.
2. The respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant £45,852.52. This is a net figure.
3. The claimant's claim for damages for breach of contract (expenses) succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant £970.89.
4. The claimant's claim for damages for breach of contract (pension contributions) succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant £17,500.
5. The hearing listed for the January 2018 will not take place.
