



# EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNALS

**Claimant:** Mr W Dixon

**Respondent:** Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd

## JUDGMENT

The claim **Failure of employer to pay or unauthorized deductions have been made (WA) and Suffer a detriment and/or dismissal relating to being. Not being a proposing to become a trade union member (TUM)** is struck out.

## REASONS

1. The claimant was ordered to pay a deposit of **£1000** following a preliminary hearing held on **21<sup>st</sup> September 2017**. The Order was sent to the claimant on **12th October 2017**. The claimant has failed to pay this deposit. The complaint of **Failure of employer to pay or unauthorized deductions have been made (WA) and Suffer a detriment and/or dismissal relating to being. Not being a proposing to become a trade union member (TUM)** is therefore struck out under rule 39(4) of the **Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013**.
