JUDGMENT

The claim Failure of employer to pay or unauthorized deductions have been made (WA) and Suffer a detriment and/or dismissal relating to being. Not being a proposing to become a trade union member (TUM) is struck out.

1. The claimant was ordered to pay a deposit of £1000 following a preliminary hearing held on 21st September 2017. The Order was sent to the claimant on 12th October 2017. The claimant has failed to pay this deposit. The complaint of Failure of employer to pay or unauthorized deductions have been made (WA) and Suffer a detriment and/or dismissal relating to being. Not being a proposing to become a trade union member (TUM) is therefore struck out under rule 39(4) of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013.
