<p><i>On the 02/09/2010 environmental permit EPR/WP3337MN was varied to increase the number of places for broiler rearing by 41%. An increase from 50,000 to 70,500 bird places was assessed and accepted by the Environment Agency.</i></p> <p><i>No other changes have taken place with regard to the activity boundaries, permitted activities or dangerous substances used or produced on site.</i></p>

<p><i>Records produced by the Environment Agency, from our regulatory team, and supporting information from the operator show that operational measures and procedures, together with decommissioning actions have not led to any environmental impact and have protected the environment as far as practicable. Pollution prevention measures have been effective and protected the state of the site.</i></p>

<p><i>During the lifetime of the permit the Operator ha stated that there have been no pollution incidents or accidents likely to have affected the soil or groundwater conditions beneath the site. No incidents have been recorded.</i></p>
