

Former Owner (Crichel Down) Considerations

Former Medical Centre at RAF Upwood, Bury, Nr Ramsey, Cambridgeshire

Medical Centre at RAF Upwood, Nr Ramsey, Cambridgeshire has been declared surplus to requirements and is being put forward for disposal. The Crichel Down Rules require Government Departments, under certain circumstances, to offer back surplus land to the former owner or the former owner's successors at the current market value.

It has been decided in this instance that an exception or exceptions under the Crichel Down Rules do apply and that the land will not be offered back to the former owners or their successors in title.
