Summary:

Within the local area (2 mile radius) of the proposed Free School, it is expected that one secondary school will feel a minimal impact and seven will feel a moderate impact. At primary, six schools will feel a minimal impact and seven will feel a moderate impact.

We were unable to assess the Kings Science Academy. This is a Free School which opened in September 2011- as it has been opened for only a few months we do not yet have sufficient data on which to make an assessment.

The secondary school aged population is projected to increase over the next few years so any potential negative impact may be mitigated by an increased demand for secondary school places in the district/local area.
