

Environment Agency permitting decisions

Surrender

We have decided to accept the surrender of the permit for Hartlepool Scrap Tin Recovery Facility operated by AMG Resources Limited.

The permit number is EPR/LP3832ST.

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid any pollution risk and to return the site to a satisfactory state.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements.

Key issues of the decision

The applicant has provided an application for full surrender with supporting evidence that comprises:

The surrender application and supporting documentation aim to demonstrate that the site has been returned in a satisfactory state. Following our review of the surrender application and supporting information we, the Environment Agency, are satisfied that the operator, has provided sufficient evidence to demonstrate that the facility and site has been returned in a satisfactory state.
