The Advisory Council on the Misuse of Drugs (ACMD) is a non-departmental public body sponsored by the Home Office to provide independent advice to the Government on drug related issues within the UK.

The Home Office is seeking members (up to seven appointments) with expertise in the following areas:

- Chemistry
- Criminal law
- Drug education and prevention
- Healthcare
- Epidemiology
- Social science

The time commitment is up to 10 days per year.

Closing date for receipt of applications is Friday 1 November 2013, with interviews for shortlisted candidates to be held during the week commencing 25th November 2013.
