

FIRE SAFETY MODULE 1

General Information

The Fire Safety Module 1 Course is designed to provide students with the functional requirements to devise and deliver Community Fire Safety initiatives on the MOD Estate:

Formal Training

The course consists of 5 days training (spread over 1 week) which currently covers:

Community Fire Safety

Target Audience

Home Fire Safety Inspections

Fire Risk Analysis

Introduction to;

- Means of Escape

- Emergency and Escape Lighting

- Fire Safety Signs and Notices

- Fire and Smoke Detectors and Detection Systems

- Sprinkler and other types of Suppression Systems

- Human Behaviour in Fire Situations

- Building Construction

- Access and Facilities for Firefighters

- Hazardous Materials

- The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order

- Managing Contractors on the Crown Estate.

The Fire Safety Module 1 is a demanding course where students are required to retain both the knowledge imparted to them and self study the précis supplied. During the course the students will have to demonstrate to the instructors that they understand the principles of Community Fire Safety by completing practical exercises.

Assessment Strategy

The students will have to complete a summative assessment which will comprises a number of; multi choice questions and short answer questions and is a closed book assessment.

The students will also have to complete Formative assessments in the following areas:

- a. Target Audience
- b. Fire Risk Analysis
- c. Home Fire Safety Inspections

Eligibility

Personnel to be trained Must:

- a. Be a minimum of DFRMO LFf/JNCO, or
- b. MOD Fire & Rescue Service Firefighter where it can be justified that there is a need for this training, and receives the approval of the BTM, or
- c. Non MOD Fire & Rescue Service personnel (subject to spare capacity, payment and prior approval of BTM).

Fire Station Managers are responsible for confirming that students nominated for the Fire Safety Module 1 course meet the above criteria.
