Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice

The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit.

The Industrial Emissions Directive (IED) was transposed in England on 27 February 2013 by the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales)(Amendment) Regulations (EPR) 2013. This variation implements changes brought about by the IED into this permit.

This facility treats non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 75 tonnes per day involving biological treatment. The waste operation was previously regulated under a bespoke environmental permit. This variation deletes all existing conditions and replaces them with a Part A installation standard rules permit, SR2012 No8 – Composting in open systems. The operator meets the criteria for this standard rules set.

Variation suffix numbers have been updated in the status log below to correct a previous numbering error. This variation will have the suffix, V005.

The schedules specify the changes made to the original permit.

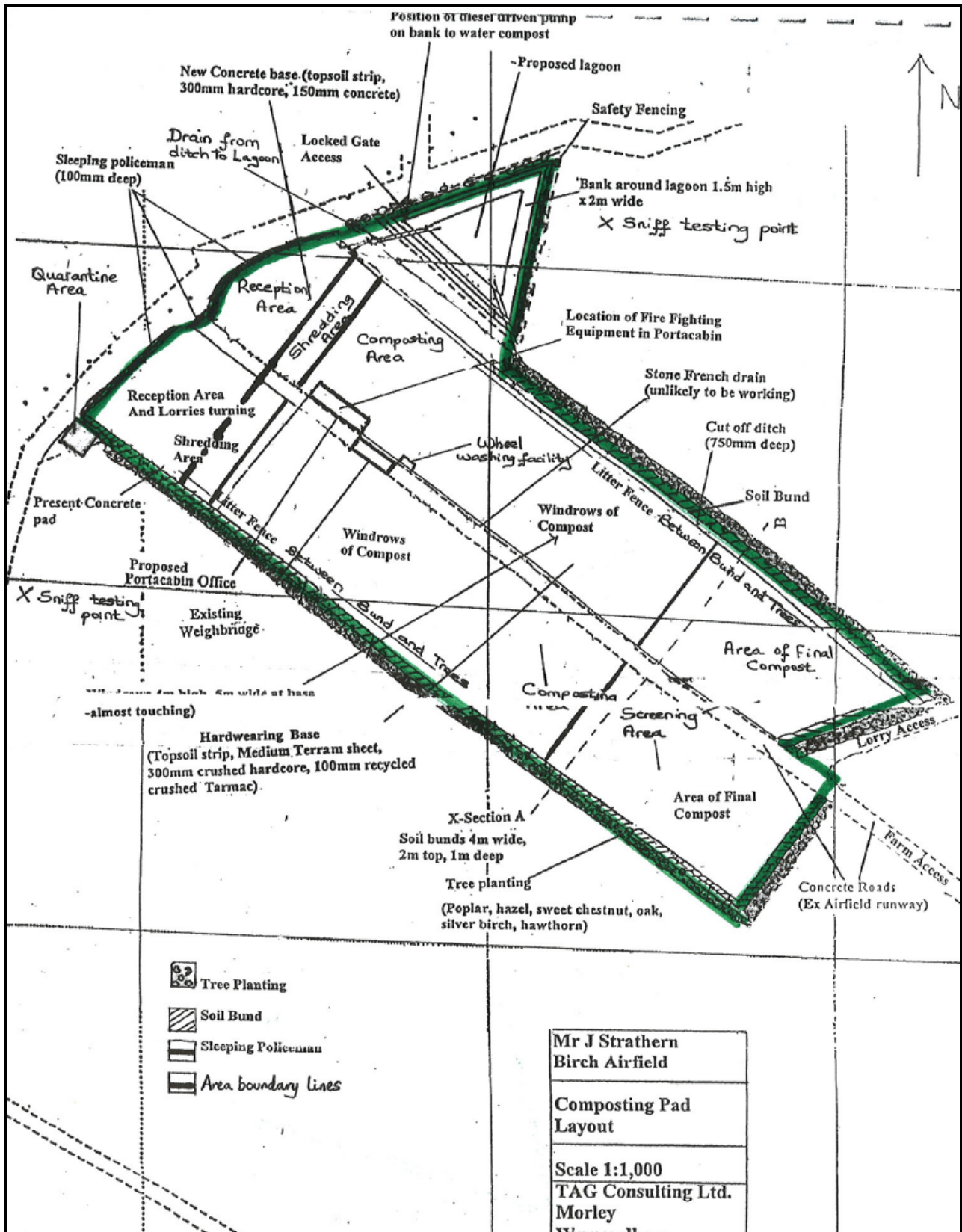
