

1) The number of approved driving instructors (ADIs) on the register

There are 46,950 current ADIs on the register. This information is correct as of 1 November 2011.

2) The number of ADIs registered for Pass Plus

There are 39,720 ADIs registered to deliver Pass Plus. This information is correct as of 1 November 2011.

3) The number of Pass Plus certificates issued by the DSA in the last 12 months, and in the preceding four years.

We released the number of Pass Plus certificates issued by month in 2005/6 to 2009/10 as part of our reply to Fol request IA/01627/10. The response to this request is available to view on our website at http://www2.dft.gov.uk/dsa/General_id_17115-cat_748-.html?nc=48Q4&id=17115&cat=748. Information on the number of Pass Plus certificates issued in 2005/6 to 2009/10 is, therefore, exempt from release under section 21 (information accessible by other means) of the Freedom of Information Act.
