#### Tori turns to painting and decorating

A "have a go" activity at The Skills Show 2013 has inspired 17-year-old Tori Hill to go on a work experience placement in painting and decorating. Tori attended the show with a mentored visit group organised by Black Country training provider BCTG, as part of the Get Involved scheme. The scheme began in July 2013 to help 68 young participants who were previously not involved in any type of education,

employment or training. BCTG organised some work experience for her at a local training provider, and is now aiming for an apprenticeship to continue her learning."
