Request for Information

Thank you for your email dated 30 September 2015 requesting information on the sale of state owned land. For ease of reference your request is below:

Could you please provide me with a list of state owned land sold since 2010, and the income received from those sales.

While ideally I would like each asset listed individually, if providing the information I am requesting in such a format would prove too expensive, I am happy for you to provide me with aggregated summaries within normally understood and identifiable categories for each year since 2010.

Information not held

The Homes and Communities Agency (HCA) is an Arm's Length Body and therefore our owned assets are not state owned.

The HCA do not monitor state assets sold from the central governments land holding. The Government Property Unit is the organisation that monitors assets across government and we suggest that you may wish to re-submit your request to them at this email address: gpusecretariat@cabinetoffice.gov.uk.

We do hold a list of assets cross government, but this is for monitoring housing capacity contribution and so cannot be used to monitor housing disposals, doesn't extend back to 2010 and is not a complete list of all government assets only those covered by the narrow use above.
