## **Extending definitive Anti-Dumping Duty to imports of stainless steel fasteners and parts thereof consigned from the Philippines, whether or not declared as originating in the Philippines and terminating the circumvention investigations concerning the product consigned from or originating in Malaysia and Thailand**

The Commission have advised by Regulation 205/2013, OJ L68, of the extension of definitive Anti-Dumping Duty (ADD) to imports of stainless steel fasteners and parts thereof, consigned from the Philippines, whether or not declared as originating in that country, with effect from 13 March 2013.

The products concerned are classified within the following commodity codes:

Two companies shall be exempted from the measures:

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\* The application of these exemptions shall be conditional upon presentation to the customs authorities of a valid commercial invoice, which shall conform to the requirements set out in the Annex. If no such invoice is presented, the rate for 'all other companies' shall apply.

The customs authorities are directed to cease registration in respect of these imports, from Thailand, Malaysia and the Philippines (measures concerning Thailand and Malaysia in this respect are terminated).

With the exception of goods produced by the above named companies, with a valid commercial invoice, customs officers are hereby directed to collect the ADD on imports of the product, consigned from the Philippines, registered from 15 June 2012.

## Annex

A declaration signed by an official of the company, in the following format, must appear on the valid commercial invoice):

1. [The name and function of the official of the company which has issued the commercial invoice.]
2. The following declaration: 'I, the undersigned, certify that the [volume] of (product concerned) sold for export to the European Community covered by this invoice was manufactured by [company name and registered seat] [TARIC additional code] in the Philippines.

I declare that the information provided in this invoice is complete and correct.
