

Environment Agency permitting decisions

Full transfer

We have decided to grant the transfer for Higher Mosserley Farm from Mr Albert Bailey and Mrs Jean Bailey (trading as A & J Bailey) to Mr Stephen Chamley, Mrs Judith Helen Chamley and Frank Chamley (trading as F W Chamley & Son).

The new permit number is EPR/VP3435AQ.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements and that the permit will ensure that the appropriate level of environmental protection is provided.

Purpose of this document

Key Issues

F W Chamley & Son has requested the transfer of Environmental Permit EPR/CP3232MX from A & J Bailey.

The permit transfer is the result of a change in operational responsibility from Mr Albert Bailey and Mrs Jean Bailey (trading as A & J Bailey) to Mr Stephen Chamley, Mrs Judith Helen Chamley and Frank Chamley (trading as F W Chamley & Son). The scope of operation and management at the installation will follow as advised in the application EPR/VP3435AQ/T001.

The Environment Agency foresee no issues with the transfer of the Environmental Permit and predict continued environmental protection through the above measures.
