
# <u>Housing Possession Court Duty Scheme Area: Birmingham, Herefordshire &</u> Worcestershire

#### Introduction

#### **Alternative Hearing Venues**

3. It is possible that some listings may be allocated by courts in the Scheme Area to Alternative Hearing Venues (e.g. another non-court venue). The use of Alternative Hearing Venues may begin or change throughout the life of the Contract. It is expected that Alternative Hearing Venues will be located either within or close to the Scheme Area. Currently, Worcester Combined Court will use Kidderminster Justice Centre and Redditch Magistrates Court as Alternative Hearing Venues.
