**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: THEFTS FROM LIBRARIES.**

I refer to your email dated 10<sup>th</sup> June 2016.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email of the 10<sup>th</sup> June 2016 you requested the following information:

**“All recorded incidents of thefts from libraries each year for the past three years (i.e. 2013, 2014 and 2015).**

**For each incident I would like:**

- The date of the offence
- The name and address of the library
- Whether this was a static library building or a mobile library
- A description of what was stolen (e.g. books, money etc)
- The value of what was stolen, and whether or not it was recovered
- Whether or not anybody was prosecuted over the theft, and their name(s)
- The outcome of any such prosecution”

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
