Dear Mr Scott,

Llanbrynmair and Charnedd Wen applications.

Thank you for your letter dated 20<sup>th</sup> September 2016 asking for comments on the re-determination of the RES and RWE application for permission to build a generating station using wind turbines.

I oppose the two applications for Llanbrynmair and Charnedd Wen for the same reasons I have put forward in the past, namely that there are no advantages which sufficiently outweigh the disadvantages to everyone apart from a few landowners and a large company. The plans will not be a cost-effective way of generating energy, with the taxpayer making a loss. There will be damage to the environment with an unacceptable visual impact and the promise to create employment is not true.

Moreover, the present government was elected on the promise that wind farms on the land would have to be more cost-effective for the taxpayer and depend a lot less on subsidies; secondly, consideration must be given to the opinion of the local community as an important factor in making the decision.
