REVISED FUNDING 2014/15 – 2015/16

I am writing to inform you of a change to the National Film and Television School's allocations for the financial years 2014-15 and 2015 -16. This letter replaces any previous notifications.

Following the Chancellor's Autumn Statement on 5 December, I am delighted to confirm that the National Film and Television Schools' allocation in 2015-16 includes capital funding of £5m for phase II of the 'Digital Village' programme. This funding will help expand and upgrade NFTS's existing facility into a word-class creative and digital skills training centre and support the UK's creative industries. I am sure you will agree that this is an extremely positive outcome for the school and for the UK talent entering the industry.

In addition, a budget reduction of around 1% has been applied to your resource grant for 2014-15 and 2015 -16.

Ministers are clear that spending on frontline services should continue to be prioritised, and that you should actively identify and implement the most cost-effective ways of delivering public services. Your grant allocations are set out in the table below:
