The new free school is unlikely to affect the long/short term financial viability of this school.

Though this school may lose some of its potential future pupils to Rugby Free Primary School it is unlikely to be in sufficient numbers to affect its long or short term financial viability.

Clifton – Upon Dunsmore is judged to be ‘Outstanding’ by Ofsted and has high attainment at KS2. It will still be popular with families, especially those wanting an education with a CofE faith ethos/designation.
St Andrew's Benn CofE (Voluntary Aided) Primary School	Voluntary Aided School	1.8	315	1	48%	Requires Improvement	06/11/2014	<b>Moderate:</b> The free school is likely to affect the short term financial viability of the school given its low attainment figure and poor Ofsted rating. Parents may decide to place their child at a new free school with the potential to offer a good or better education. However, it is difficult to accurately judge the impact as parents who want their child to attend a school with a CofE faith destination/ethos may choose St Andrew's. In addition, there is only one empty space in the current year of entry which indicates that this school is popular.
