Can you please provide me with the regulations/guidance issued to Jobcentre Plus staff who process JSA claims from the non eu spouse of a UK national who has exercised economic treaty rights in another EU member state (so called Surinder Singh cases).

As I understand it, when a UK national has exercised economic treaty rights in another EU state there are no restrictions on his spouse claiming JSA on his return to the UK as she has equality of rights of a UK Citizen.
