Thank you call and for your email dated 13 Nov 12.

We do have well established regularly reviewed security arrangements across the Estate designed to ensure that regulatory/statutory requirements are integrated with site by site additional security risk based assessments.

I can confirm as far as the short-term improvements for West Burton CCGT construction/commissioning, immediately following the breach we completed the physical razor wire permanent fenceline which was scheduled to be completed by 31st October in any event. The associated permanent monitoring (motion/breach detection, lighting, cameras etc), is still being installed which we are expediting. In the meantime, we have also increased guarding. This is all in addition to the temporary construction fence line.

In addition we are in the process of reviewing security at both West Burton and Cottam power stations. They both contain a coal and gas plant and we are reviewing security of the whole site (both plants).

The security reviews will assess the physical measures in place to detect and deter these type of events, and also to respond as necessary.
