

# Good news for sheep tagged before 2010



**Individual movement reporting for sheep tagged before 2010 has been delayed until 1 January 2015. This means:**

**NOW** – No individual recording required for non-EID sheep. Continue to report just the total number of these animals on your movement document. **However** – if you re-tag them with an EID pair, you will have to individually report their movements.

**2015** – Individual recording required. From 1 January 2015, you will need to record individual tag numbers for sheep that were tagged before 2010 on the movement document – except moves to slaughter (direct or through a market) which will continue to be batch reported.

**The new deadline is final** – make sure you can individually report movements of historic animals in your flock from 31 December 2014.
