Thank you for your email sent to the Scotland Office on 25 May 2012.

You asked for the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000:

- 1. The years of birth of all civil servants in the department, together with their educational history: details of their secondary school and any higher education, if taken
- The years of birth of all special advisers in the department, together with their educational history: details of their secondary school and any higher education, if taken

If any part of this request can be answered before any other part, please send that information first followed by subsequent information as it becomes available. If any exception is to be engaged, please provide full details of the public interest tests performed, including the arguments considered for and against disclosure and the weight applied to each factor.

The Scotland Office has completed its search for information.

Scotland Office does not employ staff directly. All staff join on a secondment type basis from other government bodies, principally the Scottish Government and the Ministry of Justice which remain the employers. It is these employers which would retain personal information in relation to the years of birth of staff in the office, possibly along with their educational history, including details of their secondary school and any higher education, if taken.

As for Special Advisers working in the Scotland Office, the information is held but it cannot be disclosed since it is exempt under the Freedom of Information Act, s 40(2). The Freedom of Information Act 2000 does not require a public interest test where the Act confers an absolute exemption. Section 40(2) is an absolute exemption.
