Thank you for your email of 17 April 2015 where you requested the following information:

"At their recent publicity display in Gosport I spoke to the army bomb disposal team about a question I have about a bomb disposal team attending for unexploded ordnance at Britannia Way Gosport, PO12 4FZ. as i would like to know the date and items dealt with in the most recent incident."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000.

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held. I am able to verify that on 8 February 2015 a 'Time Expired Pyrotechnic' was recovered in the vicinity of that postcode.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
