**7) What is the greatest number of practical driving tests a candidate at Llanelli DTC has failed (with a breakdown of category of test)? I would like this information for all the records you hold.**

From the records we hold, the greatest number of attempts to pass but failing a test was 12 attempts for the car practical test at Llanelli DTC.

Please note that this information is based on a candidate's licence number; therefore if a candidate changed their licence number, the count would start again.

**8) What is the highest number of theory tests a candidate at Swansea theory test centre has taken (with a breakdown of category of test)? I would like this information for all the records you hold.**

The greatest number of attempts to pass but fail a theory test is 22 attempts for a car theory test.

This information is based on a candidate's licence number; therefore if a candidate changed their licence number, the count would start again.
