We refer to your email dated 9 November 2016 which was acknowledged on 9 November 2016.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email of the 9 November 2016 you requested the following information:

"1. For each of the following calendar years a) 2012, b) 2013, c) 2014, d) 2015 and e) 2016 so far, please state the total number of incidents reported to your force which were flagged as being mental health related (opened with a mental health code / given a mental health qualifier).

2. For each of the following calendar years a) 2012, b) 2013, c) 2014, d) 2015 and e) 2016 so far, please state the total number of people detained by officers in your force under section 135 or 136 of the Mental Health Act (1983).

- 3. For each yearly total in question 2 (a-e) please:
- i) State the total number aged under 18
- ii) State the total number aged under 15
- iii) State the total number aged 65 or over
- iv) State the age of the youngest detained
- v) State the age of the oldest detained"

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
