DARTMOUTH - KINGSWEAR FLOATING BRIDGE COMPANY LTD - TOLL ORDER APPLICATION

- 1. I am directed by the Secretary of State for Transport to refer to the application by Dartmouth Kingswear Floating Bridge Company Ltd under the Transport Charges &c. (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1954 to revise the maximum goods weight limit on the current Toll Order for the use of the Dartmouth Kingswear Floating Bridge following a change to the maximum weight limit by way of a new byelaw.
- 2. The existing classification and the proposed amendment to the weight limits are as follows:

Current Classification and Charges		Proposed Classification and Charges	
Passenger vehicle constructed or adapted to carry 17 or more passengers (including driver) – not exceeding 16000kg maximum authorised mass Goods vehicle exceeding 7500kg but not exceeding 16000kg maximum authorised mass	Maximum £15.00	Passenger vehicle constructed or adapted to carry 17 or more passengers (including driver) – not exceeding 18000kg maximum authorised mass Goods vehicle exceeding 7500kg but not exceeding 18000kg maximum authorised mass	Maximum £15.00

- 3. The Secretary of State when considering the application has noted that the Company have indicated that there should be no immediate increase in traffic levels as a result of this change. This amendment is purely an administrative change to permit the business to operate on the basis that was presented in 2008.
- 4. The Secretary of State has noted that there have been no objections to the application received within the statutory 42 day appeal period.

- 5. On the basis of the evidence before her and having regard to her obligations under section 6 of the Transport Charges &c. (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1954, the Secretary of State is satisfied that the proposed toll order revisions are justified. The Secretary of State has therefore decided to make the Order.
- 6. The Order will come into force on 30 December 2011.
