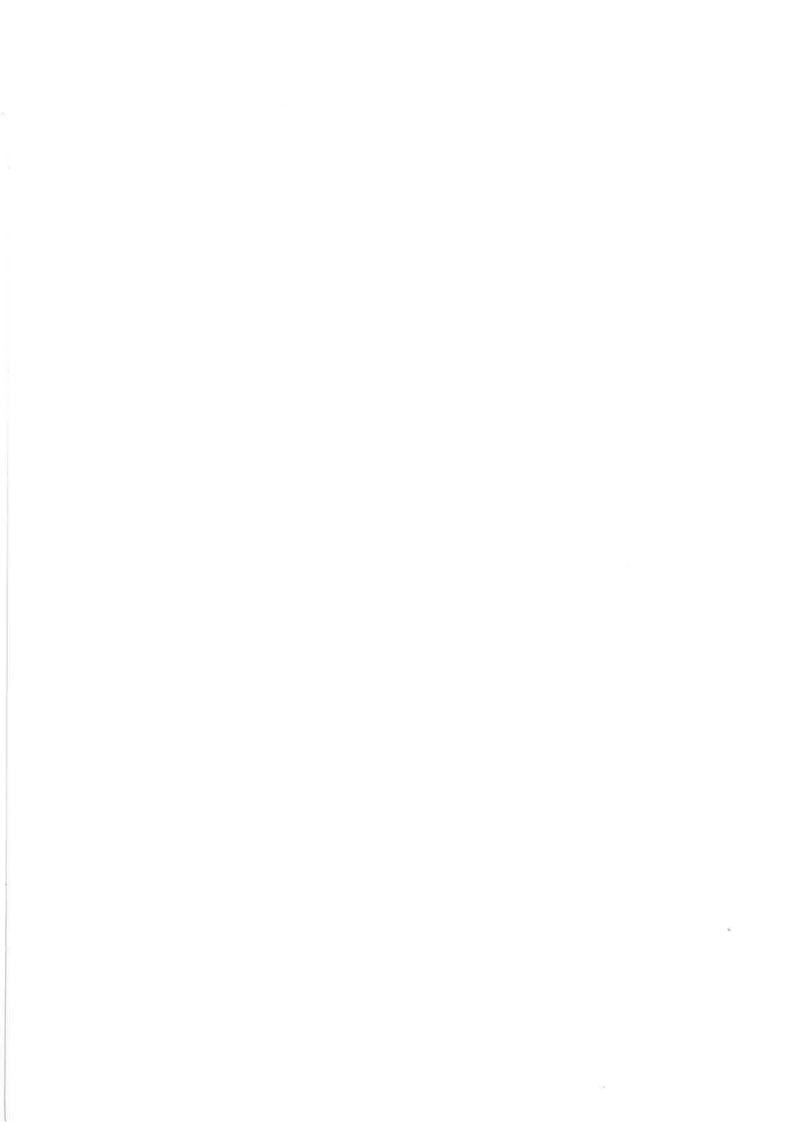

8. TRANSACTIONS WITH RELATED PARTIES

The balance of income over expenditure is paid to COT, a wholly owned subsidiary. This is in line with a Council decision. The amount to be transferred for the year ended 30 September 2016 is £6,283,368 (2015 - £5,936,539). The outstanding balance due to COT at the year end is £440,785 (2015 due from COT -£256,615).

Occupational therapists employed by COT have their subscriptions paid to BAOT by COT. These subscriptions, which are paid at normal rates, totalled £4,884 for the year.
