## Freedom of Information Act 2000 Request

You asked for the following information from the Treasury Solicitor's Department ("the Department"):

This does NOT provide me with the information I require. I need DOB, Date of Death, Place of Birth and Death, name of parents, address of parents if possible.

Your request will be dealt with by the Bona Vacantia Division ("the Division") under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The Division holds some of the information that you have requested.

You previously requested information regarding various estates. Your request was interpreted to mean you required any information held by the Division about the deceased's origins and/or extended family that will help you find entitled kin.

This included any information held by the Division about the deceased's date of birth, date of death, place of birth and death, parents' names and addresses.

All of the information held by the Division regarding each estate has been published on the unclaimed estates list.

If the information specified in your request does not appear on the unclaimed estates list, then the Division does not hold the information concerned.

Information contained on the unclaimed estates list is reasonably accessible to you by other means and is therefore exempt from disclosure under section 21 of the Act. This exemption confers absolute exemption from the requirement to provide information pursuant to section 1(1)(b) of the Act.
