Notes:

- 1. UK Regular Forces includes all trained and untrained personnel. Gurkhas, Full Time Reserve personnel, and mobilised reservists are excluded.
- 2. RAF Engineer Technicians include Aircraft Engineering Technicians, Information Communication Technicians and General Engineering Technicians.

- 3. Army Engineers have been identified in consultation with subject matter experts from the Army, using information as recorded on JPA to identify those Army personnel considered Engineers. The Army figure above excludes a number of Officers in the Royal Logistic Corp and the Royal Signals who may be considered Engineers but are not identifiable within the data that Defence Statistics hold. Defence Statistics (Army) cannot identify untrained Engineers from the data. Engineering Technicians have been identified as those from the cohort of all identified Engineers who have a Main Trade for Pay as recorded on JPA that includes the word 'technician'.
- 4. Figures are rounded to the nearest 10, numbers ending in 5 have been rounded to the nearest 20 to prevent systematic bias. "-" denotes unavilable.
