Thank you for your e-mail. Ministers have not made the distinction on the bodies that should be publishing this information but are clear the public has an interest in seeing how taxpayer's money is being spent. The request is public policy; it is not regulatory. This Department intends to issue of Code of Recommended Practice shortly for consultation, which would propose to cover Local Councils as well as other bodies.

The Local Government Group has published a set of guides to offer practical help to meet both immediate targets of publishing spending and salaries data, and to adopt approaches that will add most value for local people and public services over the longer term.
