Alternative Hearing Venues

3. It is possible that some listings may be allocated by courts in the Scheme Area to Alternative Hearing Venues (e.g. another non-court venue). The use of Alternative Hearing Venues may begin or change throughout the life of the Contract. It is expected that Alternative Hearing Locations will be located either within or close to the Scheme Area. At present, adhoc listings in Worthing Court for residents in Chichester are being heard in Havant.on Judicial direction. In addition, we are aware of two Alternative Hearing Venues. Tunbridge Wells Town Hall, Mount Pleasant Road, Royal Tunbridge Wells TN1 1RS, which will be used for one day a week to hear cases listed at Hasting County Court. The Eastbourne Traffic Commissioners Office, Ivy House Ivy Terrace, Eastbourne, BN21 4QT will be used for up to two days a week, hearing cases listed in Hastings.
