

## NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE, ENGLAND

### The Imperial College Healthcare National Health Service Trust (Amendment) Directions 2012

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 8(1), 272(7) and 273(1) of the National Health Service Act 2006(a) gives the following Directions.

#### Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Directions may be cited as the Imperial College Healthcare National Health Service Trust (Amendment) Directions 2012.

(2) These Directions come into force on 1st June 2012.

(3) These Directions are given to the Imperial College Healthcare National Health Service Trust(b).

(4) In these Directions “the Principal Directions” means the Imperial College Healthcare National Health Service Trust Directions 2012 signed on 30th March 2012(c).

#### Amendment to Direction 1 of the Principal Directions

2. In paragraph (4) of Direction 1 of the Principal Directions, after the definition of “Agency” insert—

““the Authority” means the NHS Commissioning Board Authority established by article 2 of the NHS Commissioning Board Authority (Establishment and Constitution) Order 2011;”.

#### Amendment to Direction 2 of the Principal Directions

3. In paragraph (2)(b) of direction 2 of the Principal Directions, for “Agency” substitute “Authority”.
