FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 REQUEST REF: 0971-17

Thank you for your email of 18 October asking for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. You asked for:

Copies of any and all documents - including internal and external correspondence - that the FCO (including the High Commission Kenya) holds on deceased person "Omar Faraj". He died in a Kenyan police raid on 29 Oct 2012 in Mombasa, Kenya.

Please search for those documents between the following dates 22/10/2012-31/12/2012, inclusive.

- Kindly repeat the above for "Titus Nabiswa", who died in the same raid.

I am writing to confirm that we have now completed the search for the information which you requested.

I can confirm that the Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) does hold information relevant to your request.

I attach a document titled "October 2012: A month of violence on the Coast" which mentions Mr Faraj and Mr Nyabiswa.

Under section 21 of the Act, we are not required to provide information in response to a request if it is already reasonably accessible to you. We have two pieces of information which are available on the internet;
