The following notice gives notice of the surrender in part of an environmental permit.

This Partial Surrender notice removes the activity Section 5.3, Part A(1)(a)(i) - Biological treatment of hazardous waste and associated waste code 19 07 02* landfill leachate containing hazardous substances. No hazardous waste was accepted at the leachate treatment plant under this activity as the treatment activity never commenced. No land is surrendered as part of this surrender notice.
