

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

Thank you for your request received 2 March 2016 requesting the following information:

"How many MOD staff have relocated to Corsham in the last 2 years and the intention over the next few years. I also want to find out what road the new Wadswick Green apartments will be using to go to and from their properties"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I am writing to confirm that there have been no relocations of MOD staff to MOD Corsham in the past two years and there are no plans to relocate MOD staff to MOD Corsham in the next few years.

With reference to the second part of your question:"... what road the new Wadswick Green apartments will be using to go to and from their properties" I must advise that this is not a question

which can be answered by the MOD as the Wadswick Green development is not situated on MOD property.

Under section 16 of the FOIA, public authorities are required to provide the requester with advice and assistance while processing their request. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail <u>CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk</u>). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
