FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST ABOUT CHANGES TO STAIRCASE IN THE SCOTLAND OFFICE

Thank you for your email sent to the Scotland Office on 10 March 2013. You wrote:

Please could you provide me with the following information under the Freedom of Information Act:

Details of any changes regarding a listed staircase in the Scotland Office: what was the cost of this and was permission granted by English Heritage?

I am writing to confirm that the Scotland Office has now completed its search for information. The Scotland Office leases two buildings, one in Edinburgh and one in London. Both are listed buildings. Both buildings have been altered during their history. For the purpose of this request, I have therefore limited the search for information to the last three years. I can confirm that the Scotland Office holds no information about changes to listed staircases during that period. All building and maintenance works are carried out with regard to planning and listed building regulations.
