FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 REQUEST REF: 0865-14

Thank you for your email of 6th September asking for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. You asked:

As the activity ramps up for the NATO Summit 2014 event, I am enquiring about two pieces of information:

1. What is the expected cost of bringing the event to Wales?

2. Where do the funds originate to meet this cost?

I am writing to confirm that we have now completed the search for the information which you requested.

I can confirm that the Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) does hold information relevant to your request.

The total costs have not yet been finalised but we are able to say that they are currently in line with expectations. When the costs are finalised, we expect to make the total costs for the FCO public.

As the total figures have not yet been finalised, it is too soon to state exactly where all HM Government's funding for the Summit funding comes from, as funding was agreed on a cross departmental basis.

In keeping with the spirit and effect of the Freedom of Information Act, all information is assumed to be releasable to the public unless it is exempt. The information we have supplied to you may now be published on our website together with any related information that will provide a key to its wider context.
