## **REFUSAL FORMULAE**

PLEASE NOTE: The following wordings are examples - they do <u>not</u> restitute an exhaustive list of all possible formulae.

## **ON ENTRY**

When a passenger is unable to satisfy the immigration office as to a mot other? I of abode or that he does not otherwise require leave to enter, he cannot be a rised leave of enter on that ground alone. - \* "... p sented (or produ 1 to me) a British passport No ... giving you the right of abode the United Kir dom but ..."

I have the fore decided that you require leave to enter the United Kingdom".

## AF' TRY

A right of appeal exists against refusal of a certificate of entitlement and notices of refusal hould be made on form APP103.

You have applied for a certificate of entitlement to the right of abode under section 2 of the Immigration Act 1971 as amended on the grounds that you are [a British citizen/an eligible Commonwealth citizen] but given that [...] the Secretary of State is not satisfied that ..."

- \* "... you were, on 31 December 1982, a citizen of the United Kingdom and Colonies with the right of abode in the United Kingdom under section 2 of the Immigration Act 1971 as then in force or that you have since acquired British citizenship by adoption, registration or naturalisation".
- \* "... you were such a citizen at birth or that you have subsequently acquired such citizenship by adoption, registration or naturalisation".
- \* "... you were, on 31 December 1982, a Commonwealth citizen whe eld right of abode under section 2(1)(d) or 2(2) of the Immigration Act 1971 as to in force and that you have remained such a citizen at all times since"
