A2. The Wales Office pays an agreed cost to the Ministry of Justice (see answer to 1 above). The Department does not hold the actual/budget spend in the format requested. The actual and budgeted spend for 2013/14 and 2014/15 is £128,391.

We were asked:

Q3. Please provide a list of all the ICT projects that you are undertaking; the cost of these projects and the estimated completion dates for these projects.

We replied:

A3. The Wales Office does not have any ICT projects beyond our MOJ contract.

We were asked:

Q4. Please provide a list of public sector organisations (either organisations which you fund, or shared service partners) that are included within the total ICT spend you have provided.

We replied:

A4. Please see the answer to question 1 above.
