

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY DEFINITIVE MAP ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to determine the Nottinghamshire County Council (Askham Footpath Nos. 10, 11 and 12) Modification Order 2010 proposes to modify the Order by providing for the following modifications:

- Delete from the title of the Order in the header and at paragraph 3 of the preamble to the Order and the Order map ` 11`.
- At Parts I and II of the Schedule to the Order delete the sections relating to footpath 11.
- Delete from the Order map the route of footpath 11, the annotation `Askham Footpath No. 11` and the grid reference SK 7460 7508.

A copy of the Order as submitted and a copy of the Order showing the proposed modifications together with the Inspector's Order decision dated 24 July 2015 have been deposited at the office of the Countryside Access Team, Nottinghamshire County Council, Trent Bridge House, West Bridgford, Nottingham, NG2 6BJ and may be inspected free of charge during normal working hours.
