If a decision of the First-tier Tribunal is further appealed to the Upper Tribunal, the DWP provides a submission, either explaining why the Secretary of State is appealing the tribunal's decision or a submission responding to the claimant's appeal. In either case the reasons for the First-tier Tribunal's decision is before the Upper Tribunal Judge.

Tribunal decisions are drafted by each tribunal Judge and are specific to the case being heard. DWP does not provide guidance or example decisions to tribunal judges.
