Thank you for your email of 6 February requesting the following information:

- 1. What was the established strength of the Petroleum Operator trade (by rank Pte WO1) in 2010?
- 2. What is the established strength of the Pet Op trade (by rank) under Army2020?
- 3. How many soldiers in the Pet Op trade with 7 or more years service as Pte were considered for Tranche 3 redundancy?
