## Fol request 2940/2010

Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received on 27 October 2010.

## You asked for:

- the number of complaints against DWP to this organisation in the last 12 months;
- how many of those complaints were upheld;
- how many DWP staff were disciplined as a result;
- how may DWP staff were dismissed as a result; and
- the average compensation payout to victims.

I will reply to each of your points in turn.

For the period 1 October 2009 – 30 September 2010 this office:

- received 1052 complaints about DWP;
- accepted 461 of those received, of which 30 were upheld and 59 were partially upheld;
- there are 287 complaints still being investigated;
- the remaining 85 were either withdrawn, resolved to the complainants satisfaction, or not upheld.

This office does not hold any records relating to DWP staff being disciplined or dismissed.

In terms of compensation, DWP has policy and procedures in place for paying financial redress for injustice resulting from maladministration. This office does not have an average figure of compensation paid by DWP as a Department. However, financial redress recommended by this organisation for the period 1 October 2009 to 30 September 2010 amounts to: £3,496.67 as interest for delay, £26,601.79 for actual financial loss and £10,992.77 for consolatory payments.
