### **Update on transition of services**

With two weeks to the transition date, just a reminder that from 21 July you will be able to:

- Access the DVLA's online vehicle tax service. This will allow Northern Ireland motorists to tax a vehicle or make a Statutory Off Road Notification (SORN) 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Simply go to <a href="http://www.gov.uk/taxdisc">http://www.gov.uk/taxdisc</a> or call the automated number 0300 123 4321. It takes less than five minutes.
- use additional face-to-face services at around 175 Post Office® branches across Northern Ireland, which will offer an enhanced range of vehicle tax transactions.
   Some of these branches will be open on Saturdays.

Driver licensing and vehicle testing remains the responsibility of the DVA in Northern Ireland.

#### Notifications When Vehicles Go Into the Trade

From **18 July 2014**, when a vehicle goes into the motor trade you should notify DVLA using the appropriate tear-off section of the Vehicle Registration Certificate, the V5C/3. This form should be completed by the seller, signed by both you and them and posted to DVLA. You can of course do this on behalf of your customer if they are in agreement.

This means that we will no longer issue the V7D booklet. We will however continue to accept notifications using the V8 until supplies run out. Consequently, we will no longer write to traders after three months providing a list of vehicles notified as disposed to them seeking confirmation if the vehicle has been sold on or is still in their possession.

### **Personalised Registration**

From 21 July DVLA will start to replace all current Northern Ireland V750 certificates of Entitlement with UK V750 certificates of Entitlement. The replacements will be processed in order of date of expiry and it could take a few weeks before you receive your new certificate.

DVLA will still accept applications for numbers to be assigned to vehicles as well as changes of nominee, change of address or replacement of lost certificates from Northern Ireland V750's until a replacement is received.


#### Services available for Northern Ireland Councils

This is a reminder that councils in Northern Ireland will be unable to obtain vehicle information directly from the Driver and Vehicle Agency (DVA) in Northern Ireland from 18 July 2014.

The communications sent to Northern Ireland councils on 30 April 2014 & 22 May 2014 confirmed that you will be able to request information from the vehicle record from the DVLA after 21 July 2014.

A number of councils have already enquired about the WEE service, with some close to setting up a link to this system. However, it is necessary to emphasise the timescales for setting up this connection.

With less than two weeks before the current service from DVA stops, Northern Ireland councils should contact the DVLA at the earliest opportunity to start the process of commissioning your WEE connection. 
